BUILDING NAMING	1	\$750,000	Sponsorship includes exclusive naming rights to our new residential space that houses an additional 90 women and children.
COUNSELING CENTER	1	\$250,000	Approx. 400 women and children each year will receive mental health therapy and case management services in secure, private rooms
ENTRYWAY WITH GIVING WALL	1	\$100,000	Welcoming entryway to the new residential space, including a Giving Wall, listing all donors.
COMMUNITY ROOM/LOUNGE	1	\$100,000	A comfortable gathering space for clients' community meetings, group workshops and relaxing social activities.
CLASSROOM	1	\$50,000	Brand-new workspace for high school education and employment training. Includes recognition for furniture, technology and equipment.
RED DOORS ENTRY TO BEDROOMS	1	\$20,000	Prominently-located entryway, leading to bedrooms in residential area for new women and children. Entryway receives significant traffic from guests, volunteers, and clients.
LAUNDRY ROOM	1	\$20,000	Laundry room serves all women in the 22-bedroom shelter building, who receive weekly access to facilities, a fundamental benefit for clients who were previously homeless. Adjacent to entry lobby and Giving Wall.
LOCKERS/CLIENT SECURITY	1	\$20,000	Laundry room serves all women in the 22-bedroom shelter building, who receive weekly access to facilities, a fundamental benefit for clients who were previously homeless. Adjacent to entry lobby and Giving Wall.
WOMEN'S & BOY'S SHOWERS	1 each	\$20,000	Laundry room serves all women in the 22-bedroom shelter building, who receive weekly access to facilities, a fundamental benefit for clients who were previously homeless. Adjacent to entry lobby and Giving Wall.
BREAKROOM/KITCHEN	1	\$20,000	Provides relaxing area for breaks and meals for staff and volunteers. Naming opportunity includes high visibility near classroom which holds workshops, volunteer activities and other classes.
REUNIFICATION ROOMS	3	\$20,000	Saint John's guides women who have been separated from their children through a supportive, effective and successful reunification process. Special supervised time with their children and overnight visits using bedrooms specifically designated for reunification are key to this success.
LACTATION/MEDITATION ROOM	1	\$20,000	Quiet room available for women's meditation and/or lactating mothers in a calming environment beneficial to both mother and child.
HALLWAYS WITH SAINT JOHN'S VALUES	5	\$15,000	Saint John's Program emphasizes seven values: Courage, Effort, Gratitude, Respect, Community, Growth and Love. This naming opportunity includes selection of one value for a hallway in our new shelter space.
BEDROOMS (customized at your discretion)	16	\$10,000	Each bedroom in the new shelter facility can house up to six women or two women and their children. The sponsor may choose to select a theme, decorate the room and provide a motivational quote for the room. All rooms will have sponsors' names on a plaque outside the bedroom.
IT ROOM (communications support)	1	\$10,000	Each bedroom in the new shelter facility can house up to six women or two women and their children. The sponsor may choose to select a theme, decorate the room and provide a motivational quote for the room. All rooms will have sponsors' names on a plaque outside the bedroom.
OFFICE (plaques displayed outside each office)	8	\$5,000	This room provides computer technology for the classroom, staff offices and building security.
INFANT BATHING AREA	1	\$5,000	Bathrooms include baby-washing areas to allow women to bathe their infants safely with shallow, wide sinks and counter space for drying/dressing infants.
RESTROOMS (men's/women's in lobby)	1 each	\$5,000	Restrooms near the highly-visible lobby are utilized by staff, visitors and volunteers.
RESTROOMS (men's/women's near classroom)	1 each	\$5,000	Restrooms near the classroom are utilized by clients, staff and volunteers and are highly-visible in a frequently-used hallway.
INDOOR BENCHES	5	\$3,000	In the lobby areas and hallways, benches are positioned near alumni storyboards, highlighting the success of our graduates and inspiring clients newly committing to the program.
KITCHEN TABLES	8	\$2,500	Expanding capacity to serve 270 more women and children requires new kitchen tables for meals.
FIRE SAFETY	5	\$1,000	Expanding capacity to serve 270 more women and children requires new kitchen tables for meals.
SANITATION STATIONS	5	\$1,000	Sanitation stations help ensure the health and well-being of every client, staff person and volunteer. This naming opportunity includes signage in strategic locations with high traffic and visibility.

MULTI-PURPOSE BUILDING	1	\$500,000	Multipurpose Building to include space for Fitness Room, Teen Lounge, Volunteer Space and Child Care Center
AMPHITHEATER	1	\$250,000	An outdoor amphitheater for children's plays, donor events, and other arts/performance activities.
SPORT COURT	1	\$250,000	Sports court will accommodate a basketball hoop and a net for pickleball and volleyball, encouraging outdoor activity.
THE WAY	1	\$150,000	A beautifully-lit brick pathway between our two residential buildings, to be called Independence or Freedom Way. Each brick will be individually sponsored.
FARM	1	\$100,000	Large vegetable garden in raised beds with seasonal plants and an irrigation system.
TEEN LOUNGE	1	\$50,000	Courtyard area between all three buildings, to include picnic benches with umbrellas.
COURTYARD	1	\$50,000	The teen lounge will be a gathering place for the older children in our program, serving as a community room, recreation area and place for homework, tutoring and mentoring.
CHILDREN'S PLAY AREA	1	\$50,000	Play area includes child-safe and age-appropriate activities. Naming opportunity includes selecting themes, decorations and activities.

COOKING & OUTDOOR DINING	1	\$25,000	Outdoor BBQ and dining space to encourage outdoor activity and a communal environment.
DECK DINING	1	\$25,000	
VOLUNTEER AREA	1	\$20,000	The volunteer area will be a place for work projects, volunteer activities with clients, and space to secure volunteers' belongings while they are volunteering. The naming opportunity includes selecting a theme, decorating, and furniture.
JOGGING/STROLLING PATH	1	\$20,000	Pathway to incorporate a peaceful, winding jogging or walking path so clients can exercise or walk.
CHILDREN'S VEGGIE PLOT	2	\$10,000	A beautiful "living wall" for herbs and other vine-growing produce provides greenery and fresh produce.
GARDEN HOUSE	1	\$10,000	A beautiful "living wall" for herbs and other vine-growing produce provides greenery and fresh produce.
SHADE STRUCTURE	1	\$10,000	The shade structure provides shade over the playground and picnic tables to ensure protection from the sun for women and children during outdoor recreation.
WATER FOUNTAINS	2	\$10,000	Decorative fountains will be located in the outdoor garden areas to promote tranquility and become place where women and children meditate or engage in other calming activities.
TRIKE PATH	1	\$10,000	Paved pathway with tricycle track for children's exercise and to be used by onsite childcare.
OUTSIDE BENCHES	14	\$3,000	The outside benches will be located near activity centers including the playgrounds, garden, and meditation area. Each provides a naming opportunity visible by clients, staff and visitors.
PICNIC TABLE(S)	5	\$2,500	Picnic tables are near play areas and green spaces to be used by clients, staff and volunteers. These may be used for outdoor eating as well as recreation and volunteer activities.
COMMEMORATIVE BRICKS (family)	500	\$500	Family-sponsored pavers will form path to a meditation area, a tranquil circle with benches and fountains.
COMMEMORATIVE BRICKS (Individual)	1000	\$250	Individual bricks will form a path between buildings used by clients, staff and volunteers participating in classes and other program activities.
