

Saint John's Square – Transitional Housing Program PURPOSE

Saint John's Square, a transitional housing program, provides residents with an experience in running and maintaining their household for their family.

While living at Saint John's Square, women will identify their needs and grow their own confidence and sense of well-being as they further develop skills for living independently. This prepares them to provide a safe, nurturing, and self-directed consistent living environment for their family on an ongoing basis after they move to a permanent living situation.

HOME DETAILS

- The two-bedroom, one bath units will be used as **shared** living for individuals and/or smaller families.
- Two heads of households will reside in each unit.
 - Larger bedroom has one bunk-style bed and one twin bed available (3 beds total)
 - Smaller bedroom has one bunk-style bed available (2 beds total)
- Length of residency (6-12 mo.) varies related to each woman's unique circumstances and factors.
- Units are furnished, plus a washer/dryer provided in each home.
- Monthly Fees Include Utilities
 - Larger Bedroom: \$595.00
 - Smaller Bedroom \$525.00
- There is a "No Visitor" policy on site to protect the safety and confidentiality of all participants.
- All residents must arrange for childcare to be off-site.

APPLICATION PROCESS & REQUIREMENTS

- Applicants shall have a verifiable source of income sufficient to consistently cover the cost of program fees and monthly expenses.
- All applicants are interviewed.
